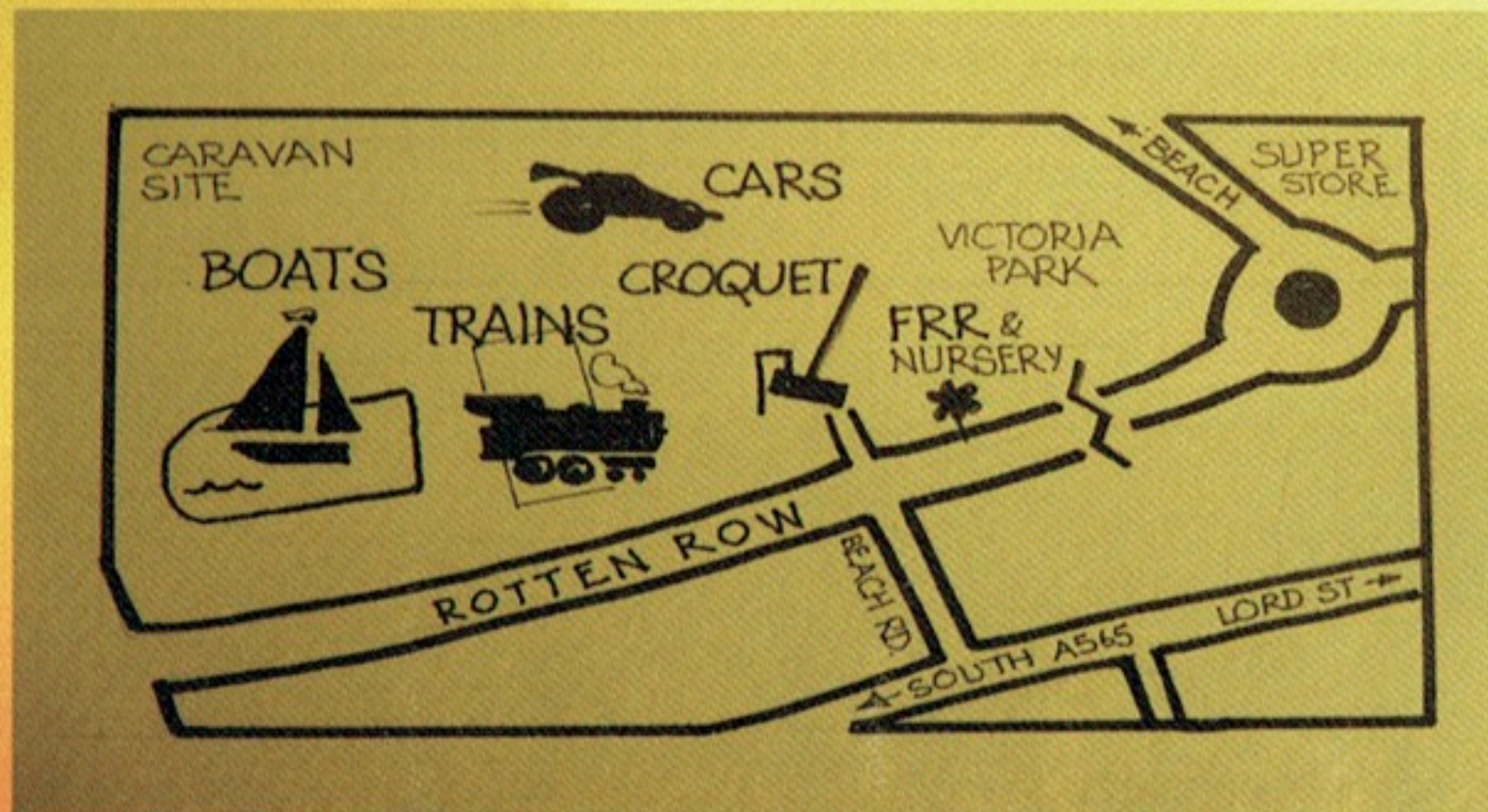
## Southport Radio Car Club

Much fun and excitement can be had at this venue, open to members and public with their own radio control models. The layout is available for use on most Sundays during the summer.

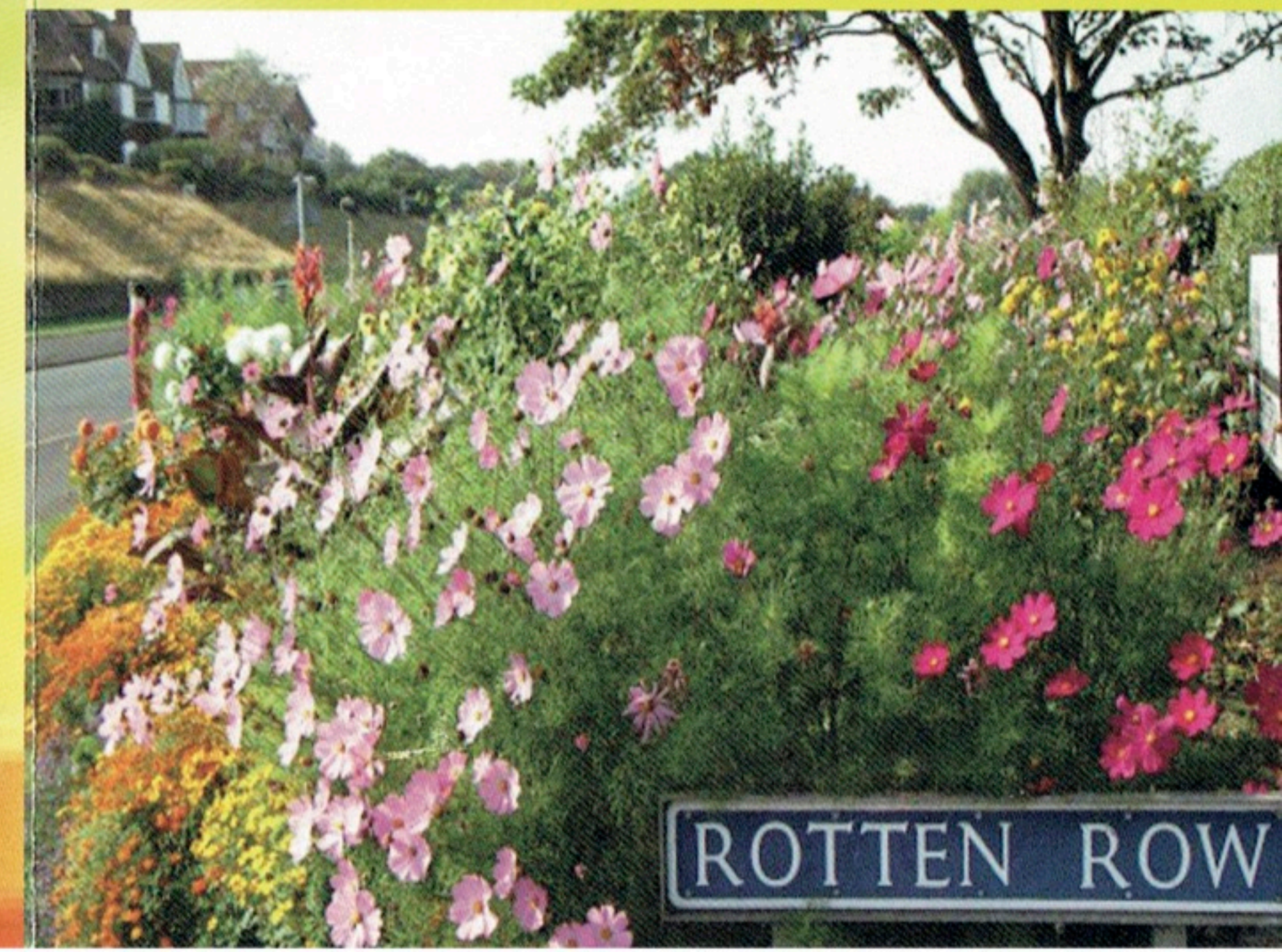

New members are always welcomed and meet in the clubroom in the nursery, halfway down Rotten Row.

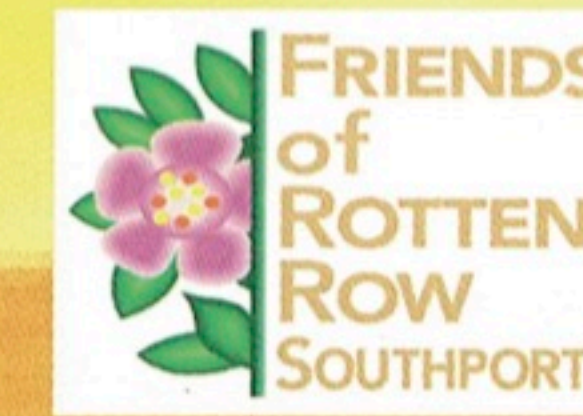
Work commences on
